Subject: Update on Empty Beer + RTD Container Returns & Sorting

Dear Valued Commercial Partners,

Following the Manitoba Liquor & Lotteries (MBLL) bulletin confirming the expansion of container deposits to Ready-to-Drink (RTD) products, WETT Sales & Distribution Inc. would like to ensure all partners have clear direction on the updated sorting requirements for RTD and Beer containers at retail beer vendors.

Attached is a simple **Empty Container Return Guide for RTD & BEER** to serve as a reference for you and your beer store staff. This guide outlines the proper sorting procedures for aluminum cans, plastic (PET) bottles, and glass bottles.

As a reminder, in addition to the containers WETT distributes, WETT Sales & Distribution Inc. is responsible for the pick-up of all containers that are distributed by MBLL.

Key Reminders:

Aluminum Cans (Beer & RTD)

- Beer and RTD cans can be combined in the same bags (based on container size)
- MBLL-distributed cans may be placed in the same bags as other cans returned to WETT

Glass Bottles (Beer)

- Bottle sorting (Private vs. MBLL) remains unchanged
- MBLL-distributed bottles must be sorted separately from other containers being returned to WETT
- All bottles are collected by the dozen, regardless of size

PET Bottles

- PET bottles under 2L are to be sorted and collected in bags of 40 bottles
- PET bottles 2L+ are to be sorted and collected in bags of 40 bottles

We appreciate your attention to these requirements and your continued support in ensuring consistency and compliance across the market.
